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Research Objectives

Research Strategy and Research Design

Mixed - Qualitative (explanatory) and Quantitative (exploratory, descriptive)

Research Methods/ Data Sources

- Under quantitative analysis, secondary data is being gathered through a review of related articles in academic journals, periodicals, policy documents, academic reports and annual reports published by the Government of India, the Department of Telecommunications, the International Telecommunication Union, and the GSM Association (GSMA), among other sources. This is assisting in comprehending the numerous indicators that are responsible for the implementation of the USOF.
- Under qualitative analysis, primary data is being collected using survey method by carrying out survey of telecom subscribers of Meghalaya, officials of USOF, Telecom Service Providers and State Government of Meghalaya by using semi-structured tool on quality of broadband availability using both open ended and closed ended questions. Data hence captured would be analyzed using appropriate tools.
